

The current number of students we are serving is:

Travis Elementary 9 We get food from the North Texas
Food Bank.

North Hopkins ISD 25 We purchase this food locally. Como-Pickton CISD 66 We purchase this food locally.

It costs about \$3 per week for each student. For 91 Backpack Buddies, that is around \$273 per week.

Tira UMC sends a donation each month to help cover the costs for North Hopkins. We have received donations recently from Beckham Baptist Church, Greenpond Ladies Class, and Danny Evans, County Commissioner.

From Pastor Steve

From Thanksgiving to Advent to Christmas to Epiphany!

Our Music and Young Minister, Joe Clark, asked me last week: "Pastor, do you want to go straight into Advent/Christmas music or to 'ease '

into it?" I replied rather quickly, "Let's ease into it, Joe. We still need to be sharing that gratitude-attitude at least into December!"

Let me list some of my thankfulness or gratitude for our church, Wesley UMC:

- For our hard and all-out work on two "treasure hunts" (garage sales): one to support our sweet Eisley Henderson and the other to support our ministries and budget at Wesley.
- For Rick and Cheryl Spears (and a few others of us) who represented Wesley at the 2016 Hopkins County Stew Festival.
- For the Wesleyan Sunday school class-sponsored October all-church lunch in October and the Cornerstone/ Harvey Crusaders/Lifeway Sunday school classes in November.
- For our annual Charge Conference report in November in Greenville.
- For our all-church Wednesday Thanksgiving dinner with over 150 folk attending.
- For our adopted Cub Scout Troop 77 and their weekly ministry.
- For our Little Acorn Pre-school Program-year-round learning and fun.
- For hosting NA groups and TOPS ladies year round.
- For out successful 2016 Fall Roundup raising 13,398 for Wesley ministries.
- For staff and committees working for the glory of God together.

And friends, most of these things have occurred in the last 60 days! Wow! And the next 40+ days will be filled with making memories, worship, and JOY! Let me highlight some of these events and activities:

- Advent began last Sunday, November 27. Each of the next 4 Sundays, we will have Wesley folks leading in "Calls to Worship."
- We will celebrate Christmas Eve with special music, a Christmas story skit, and closing with Candlelight Communion starting at 6:00 p.m.
- With both Christmas and New Year's Day falling on Sundays, our Worship Committee has set a 10:00 a.m. Devotion and no Sunday school.
- January 6, 1952, was the first worship service held at our church. We will celebrate our 65th Church Anniversary on Epiphany Sunday, January 8, at 10:00 a.m. followed by an all-church anniversary luncheon. We have invited back former Pastors and families for this event. We will also send invitations and information to any former members we can contact as well as advertise in the newspaper, on radio, and on Facebook as well as our Wesley website. This will be a

unique, planned service with our guest pastors and friends helping us to praise God for our 65 years of ministry!

I am humbled by the privilege of serving as Wesley's pastor. Several of you have stepped up and stepped out to be faithful in your service to Jesus Christ our Lord these past 60 days. I can only say "thank you" from my heart. And you are fleshing out our recent motto: "A Place of Grace."

Fresh on my mind is a "frozen moment" I experienced with Shirley and Jerry Glossup (with Jerry in the hospital at the time). It was the Tuesday before Thanksgiving and, of course, we were all talking about food and family. With the sound off on the TV in Jerry's room, Jerry was looking at a news story where 5 children were killed in a bus accident in Chattanooga, TN. Not all of the facts were in (at the moment), but an apparently speeding bus wrapped around a tree killing the 5 and wounding several others. It was Shirley who spoke and put everything into perspective: "And, ya'll, here we are talking about food to cook and eat and these families are hurting." I say a "frozen moment" because, of course, this loss of life story, especially affecting little ones, always outranks any feel good moment we experience.

Let's remember: "Only by the Grace of God are we forgiven, accepted, restored, and saved." When we believe (have faith) and receive this awesome free gift of God, our Journey of Grace through Faith "exceeds our sin and our guilt!" No wonder it is known as *Amazing Grace*, *How Sweet the Sound!*

Civil Air Patrol

This Sunday marks the 75th Anniversary of the Civil Air Patrol - "America's Best Kept Secret." Civil Air Patrol, the long-time all-volunteer U.S. Air Force auxiliary, is the

newest member of the Air Force's Total Force, which consists of Regular Air Force, Air National Guard, and Air Force Reserve, along with Air Force retired military and civilian employees.

CAP, in its Total Force role, operates a fleet of 550 aircraft and performs about 85 percent of continental U.S. inland search and rescue missions as tasked by the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center and is credited by the AFRCC with saving an average of 70 lives annually.

Civil Air Patrol's 58,000 members nationwide also perform homeland security, disaster relief and drug interdiction missions at the request of federal, state and local agencies. Its members additionally play a leading role in aerospace education and serve as mentors to more than 24,000 young people currently participating in the CAP cadet program.

Civil Air Patrol received the Congressional Gold Medal in 2014 in honor of the heroic efforts of its World War II veterans. Congressionally chartered 75 years ago, the nonprofit organization also participates in Wreaths Across America, an initiative to remember, honor and teach about the sacrifices of U.S. military veterans.
