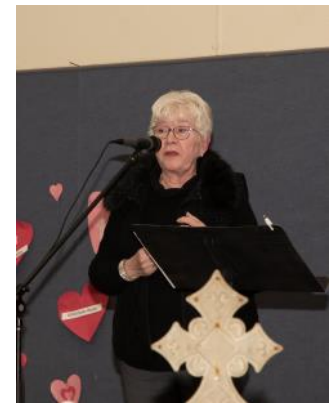
George and Kay have 5 adult married children and 10 grandchildren!

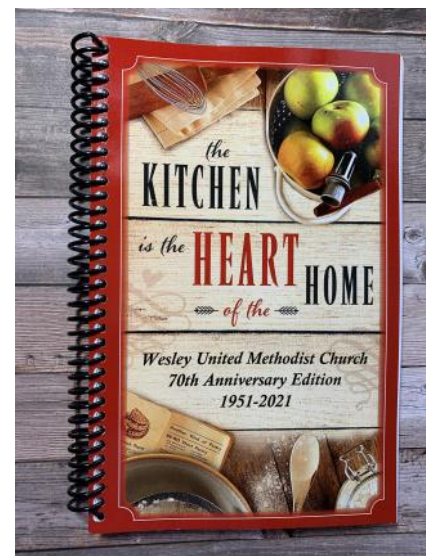
